



## Elements of True Worship (Revelation 4:8-11) (REV60)

“Worship” translates the Greek word **προσκυνέω** (proskuneo) – to prostrate before in order to kiss one’s feet, the hem of his or her garment, or the ground. The English word carries the idea of “worth-ship.”

‘Holy’	<b>ἅγιος</b>	True worship acknowledges God’s holiness, separateness
‘Eternal’	<b>ὁ ἦν καὶ ὁ ὢν καὶ ὁ ἐρχόμενος</b>	True worship acknowledges God’s eternity
‘Glory’	<b>δόξα</b>	True worship recognizes God’s brightness, splendor
‘Honor’	<b>τιμη</b>	True worship extols God’s preciousness, value and worth
‘Thanks’	<b>εὐχαριστία</b>	True worship is conducted in an attitude of thankfulness and appreciation
‘Falling down’	<b>πίπτω</b>	True worship involves being prostrate before the Lord
‘Giving or Throwing’	<b>βαλοῦσιν τοὺς στεφάνους</b>	They liberally “ <i>throw</i> their crowns” back to the Lord.
‘Power’	<b>δύναμις</b>	True worship acknowledges God’s omnipotence
‘Creator’	<b>ὅτι σὺ ἔκτισας τὰ πάντα καὶ διὰ τὸ θέλημα σου ἦσαν καὶ ἐκτίσθησαν</b>	True worship acknowledges God’s sovereignty as the Creator of all things

Also, according to **John 4:24** all true worship must be:

- Accomplished in the filling of the Holy Spirit, and
- Must be defined by, or in accordance with, the Truth (God’s Word).
